

Restaurant Choices near Artscape Wychwood Barns

The Stockyards

699 St Clair W., 416-658-9666

This narrow restaurant (more of a diner, mostly takeout) serves up mighty fine barbecue. Take a pulled pork sandwich and potato salad to the picnic tables at Artscape Wychwood Barns.

Savera Indian Cuisine

The first thing that will hit you is the smell. As soon as you walk in, you know that the food is going to be good! The place smells amazing! The restaurant is small maybe 12 small tables with a small patio. The dark décor is nice and casual. A warning for those of you who can't handle the heat: their food definitely has a kick to it!

Mezzetta Café Restaurant

This place is indeed a little gem. If you are the kind of person who loves food variety (test: when was the last time you stuck your fork into another person's plate because you didn't want to miss out?) you are going to love Mezzetta. The menu is made up of dozens of little dishes that are cheap enough to order by the handful.

Taste of Thai House

This is a cute cozy little place that serves simple yet extremely fresh and tasty Thai food. A winner for sure! The restaurant itself looks pretty low-grade, but don't let appearances fool you: the food here is great, with unpretentious and made to order service.

El Fogon

With great staff, nice cozy ambience and decor and an authentic Peruvian menu, El Fogon is a favourite to many. The food isn't overly hot or spicy so it's compatible with a lot of palettes. If you're not big on hot, avoid the little garlic chili dip that comes with the complimentary bread.

El Ricon Mexicano Restaurant

The place is tiny and is easy to pass by if you are driving on St. Clair but worth seeking out. Inside, the brightly light, lively decor is set to a backdrop of Mexican music playing on the speakers. The menu has a mix of all the traditional Mexican foods you would want to eat. El Rincon Mexicano Restaurant is as authentic as it gets in Toronto.

Nama Sushi

It's hard to find sushi restaurants where the owner and sushi chef are actually Japanese. You'll know the difference immediately when you see the cuts of fish and the taste in quality. Nama has a great selection of fish and rolls, but not too much to overwhelm you. The sushi chef knows what he's doing. He picks the freshest fish, rolls tight stuffed rolls and has the most magical salad dressing.
